SLIMWALL Mouldings Hanging instructions

General conditions

- Check that the product delivered matches the order (reference, length, batch number, colour) and that it has not been damaged during shipment (if this is the case put a proviso on the carrier's delivery note)
- D.T.U 59.4 « Mise en oeuvre des papiers peints et revêtementsmuraux » edited by AFNOR according to standards NF P 74 -204 -1&2 sets out the rules for hanging of wallcoverings and theresponsibility of the installer. It will be used in case of a dispute
- Recommended conditions : +10 °C < Temperature > +30 °C Humidity < 65 %HR

Prepare the walls

The installer is responsible for preparing the walls A WELL-PREPARED BASE = 80% OF THE SUCCESS

• The base (walls) must be:

Robust: the wall must be strong, stable and hard. Sound and dry: humidity treated, saltpetre and mould

Clean: remove dust, previous wallcoverings, and wash. Smooth and flat: to ensure a beautiful finish. Uniform: to avoid show through.

• Normally absorbent (water drop test), otherwise :

For new substrates which are too absorbent (plaster, render, plasterboard, concrete) should be primed using a thin layer of Metylan 1200 or diluted acrylic paint. Old soft crumbling plaster should be treated with Metylan I 400

hardener or diluted glycerophthalic primer diluted with 20 to 30 % white spirit. Old non-absorbent walls (varnish or old paint in perfect

condition) should be washed with alkaline and rinsed.

Choice of paste

- On normally absorbent substrates :OVALIT TM, brand Metylan, manufacturedby HENKEL Apply with a medium nap roller such as a 12mmpolyamide roller or with a spatula. Apply generously upto +/- 250 g/m²
- On non-absorbent substrates : OVALIT F (+/- 250 to 300 g/m²)
- Adhesive suitable for skirting boards and picture rails (acrylic mastic)

Recommendation

- Skirting boards with a 9mm recess to accommodate the product (sold by Texdecor)
- Skirting boards in the case of a basement
- Raw SlimPanel sheet

Specificity

Socket installation:

It is recommended to install a projecting socket. If the cutout is made in a recess, glue a flat sheet of maximum 4.5 mm thickness in the recess next to the socket.

Spirit level and square




- 1. Paint the skirtings and picture rails.

Install the finishing rail.






Hang a plain SlimWall panel to be cut with a cutter or circular saw.






Bevel cut in the corner

SLIMWALL Wall Panelling Hanging instructions

General conditions

- Recommended conditions:
 +10 °C < Temperature > +30 °C
 Humidity < 65 %HR

Prepare the walls

The installer is responsible for preparing the walls A WELL-PREPARED BASE = 80% OFTHE SUCCESS

• The base (walls) must be:

Robust: the wall must be strong, stable and hard. Sound and dry: humidity treated, saltpetre and mould removed

Clean: remove dust, previous wallcoverings, and wash. Smooth and flat: to ensure a beautiful finish. Uniform: to avoid show through.

• Normally absorbent (water drop test), otherwise :

For new substrates which are too absorbent (plaster, render, plasterboard, concrete) should be primed using a thin layer of Metylan 1200 or diluted acrylic paint.

Old soft crumbling plaster should be treated with Metylan I 400 bands are still the distributed with 20 to 20

hardener or diluted glycerophthalic primer diluted with 20 to 30 % white spirit.

Old non-absorbent walls (varnish or old paint in perfect condition) should be washed with alkaline and rinsed.

Choice of paste

- On normally absorbent substrates :OVALIT TM, brand Metylan, manufacturedby HENKEL
 Apply with a medium nap roller such as a 12mmpolyamide roller or with a spatula. Apply generously upto +/- 250 g/m²
- On non-absorbent substrates : OVALIT F (+/- 250 to 300 g/m²)
- Brand Metylan, manufactured by HENKEL, apply with a foam CREPI FIN (plaster) roller

Recommendation

- - Skirting boards (sold by Texdecor)
- 18x18mm battens for installation on adjacent walls (not supplied)

Specificity

• Socket installation: It is recommended to install a socket in a recess. If the cut-out is made in a recess, glue a flat sheet of maximum 4.5 mm thickness in the recess next to the socket.




1. Lay the skirting and then the strip in the corner if necessary. Start the installation at a lower corner. To


do this, cut off the edge



Keep the offcuts of the first panel. They can be used to complete the final panel.


- 2. Hang the first panel, then the secondinverting the direction. Hang the rest keepingto the same system until you reach the end. Trim the edge and check with a spirit-level.
- 3. Use the final offcut to start a new layerthen repeat steps 2 and 3 as many times asnecessary to cover the surface.







-Precision for London : In order to respect theaesthetics, include a distance of 10 cm.
